When it comes to presents, try to reduce, or eliminate, the amount of plastic you buy for presents. Again, reducing what you buy, buying local, or making something yourself for someone will reduce the carbon footprint of your Christmas. Think about presents that do not require batteries or, if unavoidable, use rechargeables. Can you find creative ways of wrapping your presents rather than buying Christmas wrapping paper? (Oxfam sell recycled wrapping paper). Can you reduce your Christmas card list to those you won't actually be able to see in person? There are many Christmas cards now that are printed in the UK on recycled paper. Or you can make your own from old cards or your own design. It's a chance to be creative.
